## RECAP

Questers' Giving Programme has been active for more than 14 years now, but 2022 was one of the most successful years for the programme so far.

Last year, the total amount raised and donated through Questers Giving Programme was 46 849 BGN.

Most of this amount (33 023 BGN) was donated by our employees, doubled by Ouesters and then directed to various educational initiatives. In addition, through other campaigns, we collected and provided another

to other social causes.

### WHAT HAVE WE ACHIEVED IN THE FIRST QUARTER OF 2023?

This year, we have set the goal to raise and donate

#### 35 000 BGN

together with our employees through the Questers Giving Programme. This amount will include the donations made through the purchase of "charity vouchers" from the social benefits package, which Questers will be doubling and donating in support of various educational initiatives and organizations. Our aim is to make a positive impact on society and create a better future for all.

We are thrilled to announce that in the first quarter we have successfully raised a total of 7 800 BGN. These funds will support the largest free IT initiative for students in Bulgaria - Telerik Academy School, which provides equal access to modern technology education for students across the country.

Looking ahead to the 2023-2024 academic year, they'll be working to establish 100 free schools throughout Bulgaria, providing 200 students with the opportunity for digital learning. In addition to this, the academy has set an ambitious goal to integrate their learning programmes within the state schools and as a result to train nearly 30 000 students within 5 years. Telerik Academy School's mission aligns with our goal to support education and to help pave the way for a brighter future in Bulgaria
